No fees charged

by the EPO for the request for a Unitary Patent (UP)



Attractive fee level

with renewal fees for maintaining a UP for 10 years in 18 countries amounting to EUR 5 036



Reduction of 15%

of the renewal fee for the registration of an intention to licence a UP



UPC is the only jurisdiction

for infringement proceedings

REQUEST FOR UNITARY EFFECT: REQUIREMENTS

Substantive requirements

Unitary effect can be requested for European patents that were granted

- in respect of all 25 participating member states and
- with the same set of claims for all of them

Formal requirements

- filing of the request by the patent owner in writing, including via online means, in the language of the proceedings
- no later than one month after the mention of the grant is published
- translations only during a transitional period (2023-2030)

REQUEST FOR UNITARY EFFECT: PRACTICALITIES




Filing is free of charge, payment of renewal fees due on the anniversary

Can be made by proprietor (or EP representative) after obtaining a European patent (or earlier upon receipt of the notice of publication)








UNITARY PATENT UPTAKE AND PROPRIETOR MAKEUP UNTIL 14.07.2025
